


Refreshed and Ready for Action




Donations

- Any unopened bags of play sand




Maths Workshops and Drop in

To help develop the learning of the children and support parents and carers we hold workshops and drop in sessions on different subjects on a regular basis. Next half-term, we will be focusing on Maths. On **Monday 6th November** from **6:00pm** – **7:30pm** we will hold our workshop. During this time our Maths lead (Mrs Wood) will go over key principles for teaching Maths.
